Around 80 % students absorbed by NGO/MFI/others

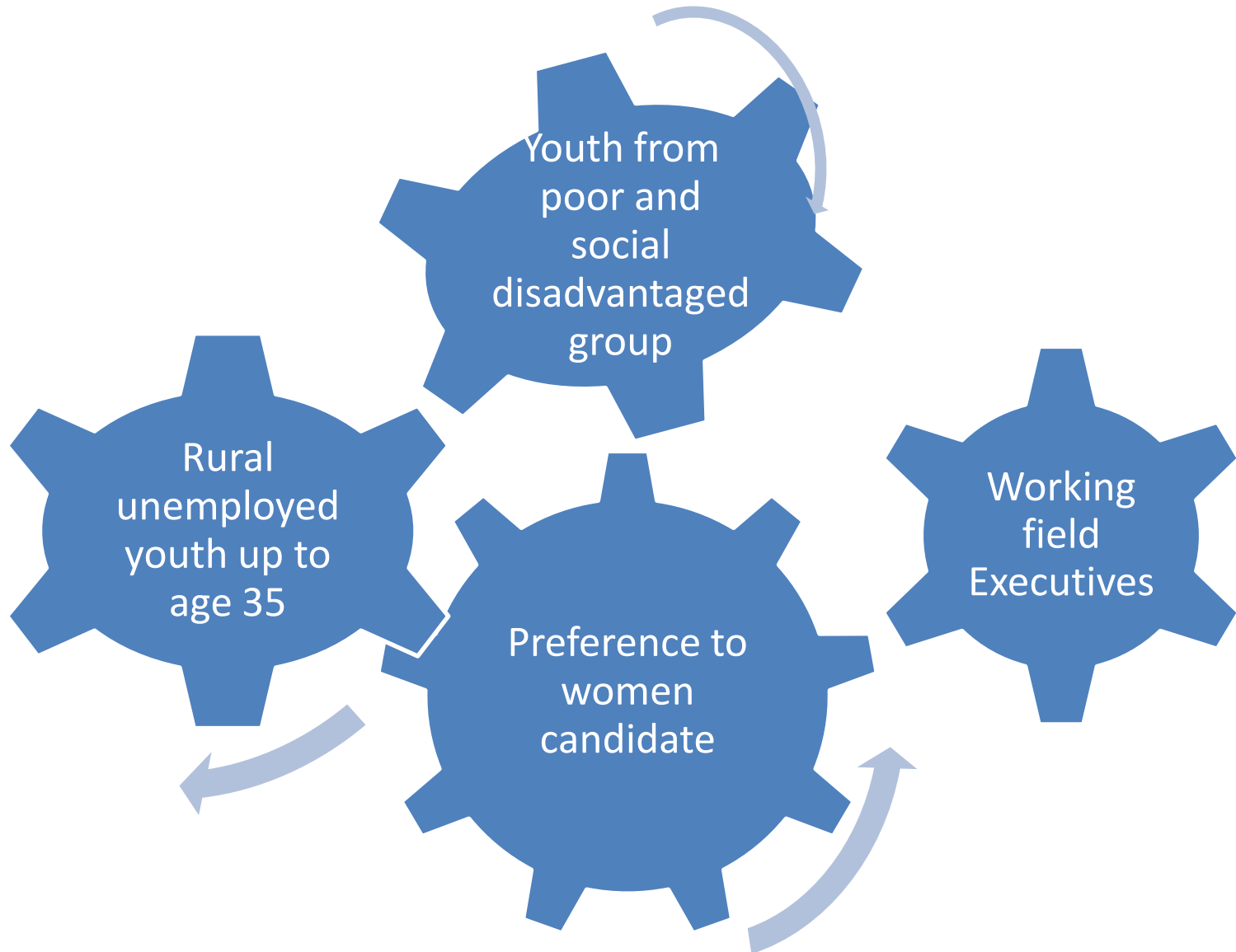
Starting salary Rs. 6000-8000 and has gone up to Rs. 30,000 in four years for deserving candidates

Placement in leading Federation/NGOs/MFI/Banks/CSR

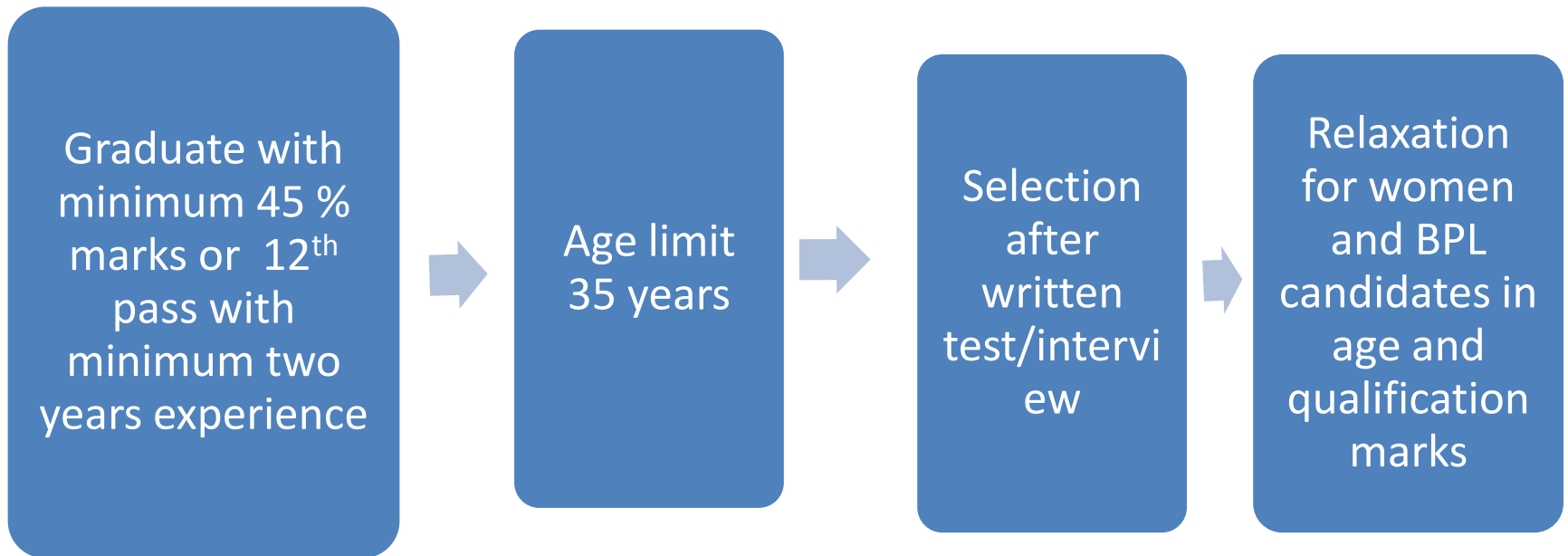

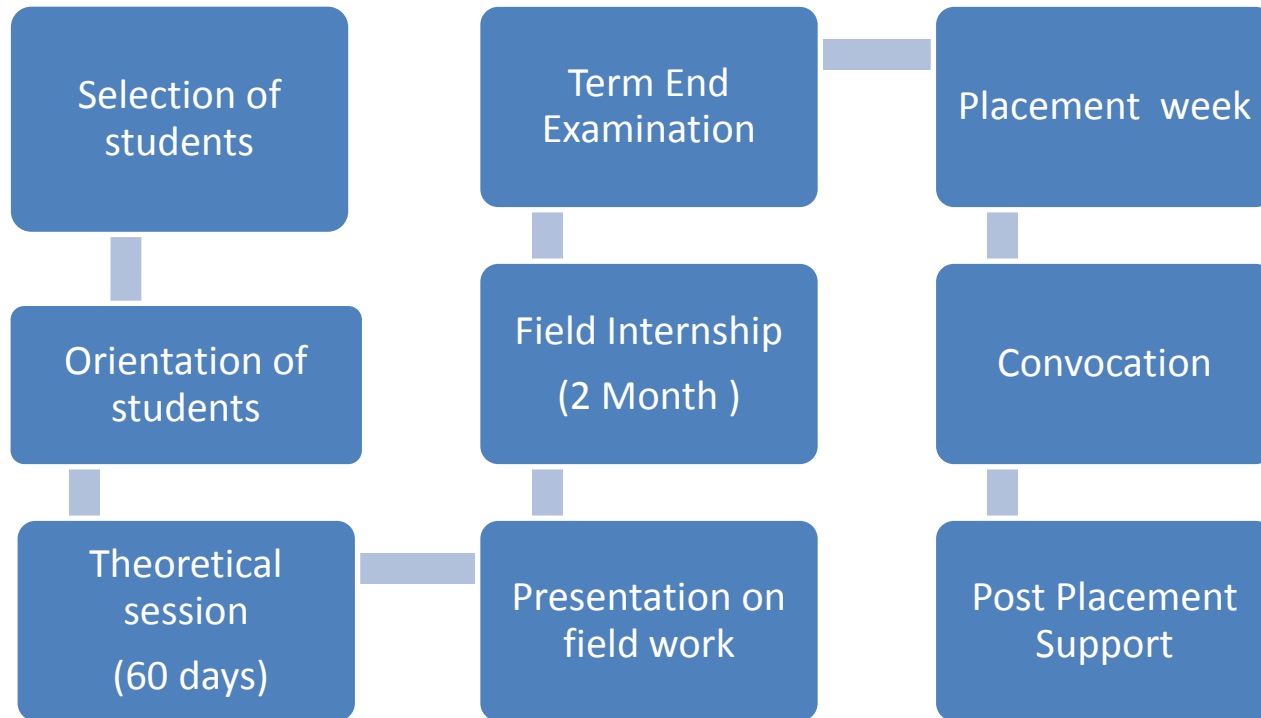

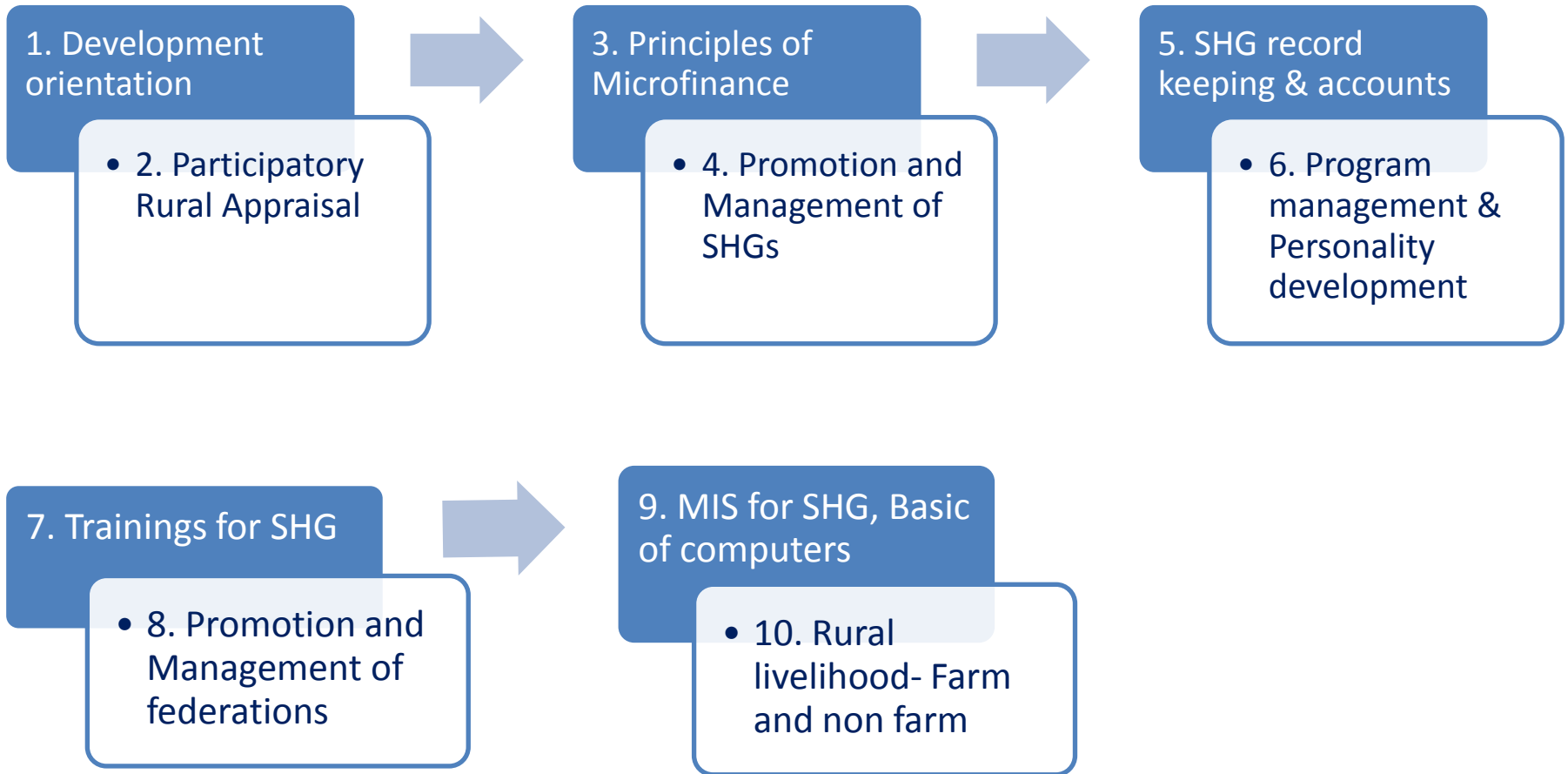
